Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Connecticut State Law requires a physician's or dentist's written order and parental or guardian's authorization for a school nurse to administer medication to students. In the absence of the nurse, a principal or teacher may administer the medication.

The Gengras Center and the school medical advisor have established a policy and a standing order for the school nurse to administer Acetaminophen, Ibuprofen, antacids, or cough drops to students. This medication may be administered for minor problems during school hours with written authorization from the parent or guardian.

This authorization **must be** renewed each year. You may withdraw this authorization to administer medication by notifying the school nurse's office. Please fill out this form and return it to the school immediately. If you have any questions, please contact the school nurse.
